## **FROM THE VICE PRESIDENT**

*January 2011 marks 20 years since the start of Desert Storm. I was a reservist in the 913<sup>th</sup> TAG at Willow Grove ARF, PA and had planned to retire February 1991, with 20 years' service. During the call-up of reservists and guardsman, my supervisor had assured me that I would be able to retire. However, one week before Christmas, 1990, I received a call letting me know that I was to report to the base the day after Christmas for activation. So much for retiring!*

*Our Group had 12 C-130E models and about 300 maintenance personnel. As it turned out, all of the aircraft and 270 personnel ended up going to the desert,*

*with the balance going to Rhein Main AB, Germany. I was in the 30 that went to Germany.*

*After arriving at Rhein Main we were assigned to our specific duty stations. I was the second shift Section Supervisor of the various shops that supported the heavy maintenance work on the aircraft returning from the desert. We had a very tight turn-around schedule to get the aircraft back to the desert and everyone did their best to stick to the schedule. The reservists (now active duty) and full time active duty personnel worked hand in hand with virtually no problems. We worked 12 hour shifts, 7 days a week, with little if any time off.*

*We stayed in Germany for about 3 months and returned to Willow Grove on Good Friday. I stayed in the reserves for another 2 years and then retired in March, 1993, with 22 years of service (4 active duty and 18 in the reserves).*

*Looking back at the time that I was activated, I was amazed at the ability of both active and reserve members to blend together in order to accomplish the tasks at hand and work almost seamlessly to achieve a common goal. All of the training that we did on reserve weekends paid off. I know that a lot of people think that the reservists are nothing more than “weekend warriors” but the truth is that they are truly the backbone of the services. Most reservists now do more than one weekend a month and 2 weeks active duty during the year. Some have been activated for months if not years at a time.*

*Would I do it again? Sure I would. I had a great time and would recommend*

*it to anyone looking for a satisfying career.*
